

King's Inquisitors Obliterated



After several complaints were filed with Orchestral Knights of Evendarr regarding the methods and behaviors of a number of men who arrived in the Duchy in early spring bearing writs of Inquisitorship signed by Sir Tivorak Nobel, all eight men and their immediate supervisor were sentenced to deaths and executed this summer.

The men, sent out in pairs to Ravenholt City, the Stonewood Forest, the Mystic Wood, and other key locales throughout the Duchy are reported to have used Dominate poisons and even, in one case, attempting to use Enslavements while questioning both citizens and nobles of the region.

The focus of their investigations appears to have been concern about this Fall's Eastwyck rebellion and whether other courts and citizens were similarly minded in their desire to secede from the Kingdom. Several individuals placed fairly high up in the military, who spoke to the Herald on conditions of anonymity, were able to confirm that some of the questions asked of them during their uncomfortable meetings with these men seemed interested in the leadership and behavior of not only Ravenholt's barons and lesser nobles, but of Duke Stemple himself.

After the Inquisitors had come through town, one noble of the land was overheard angrily declaring "They didn't need to Dominate me. I'm a noble. I said exactly what I'd have said without that intrusion!" Apparently the methodology went over even more poorly in the Mystic Wood, where the Inquisitors made an attempt with several prominent citizens but were soon "escorted fervently to the edge of the Wood and discouraged from returning at any cost." Word from the Stonewood Forest of like incidents is more stoic, but equated to similar result. A representative from the Stonewood Forest is believed to have visited Ravenholt City last gather to discuss concerns about these matters.

Despite confirmed reports of the "by any means necessary" nature of the writs these men were granted, complaints were clearly heard. The men were recalled to Evendarr City and an investigation ensued. It was made clear that Sir Tivorak by no means approves the use of Dominates and Enslavements on nobles of Evendarr and that the men had taken actions deemed illegal and inappropriate, especially when

done in the name of the First Knight of the Orchestra. "Sir Tivorak knows that nobles of Evendarr are sworn to uphold its laws and he would never condone criminal acts to uncover other criminal acts," said one individual close to King Mykel.

All eight men and the overseer who'd assigned them their investigatory duties and territories were found guilty of multiple charges of Assault and acts of Treason. While a discussion of multiple Deaths by the Sword was put forth for punishment, the King's Laws held true and all nine were sentenced to Obliteration. One man was also accused of two counts of Slavery for his use of Enslavements during the investigation and was given two additional Deaths by the Sword. He survived the Obliteration but died his permanent death at the first Death by the Sword. The overseer and one other Inquisitor did not survive their Obliterations. Many of the men assigned these tasks had military background and had already died several times over fighting on Evendarrian fronts prior to their retirement to less active duty.

It is unclear as to whether there will be repercussions for any citizens who failed to be fully forthcoming and give aid to the Inquisitors when they were actively investigating, as to do so was potentially a criminal act as they did represent the Crown, despite their own criminal actions during the investigations.

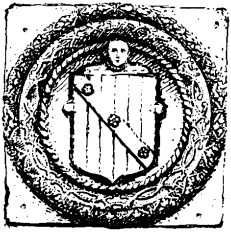
Princess Lillian Rotari Killed

Copper Dreadfuls and Strange Roads

A strange, grey-skinned lizard-like man was seen running into town at the last gather, seemingly chased by unusual copper-sheened constructs that were vaguely reminiscent of Clock-

works. Each bore an etching of a silver humanoid figure upon its chest. While those chasing him were dispatched with ease, other such creatures appeared throughout the gather. They seemed to be hunting for something, asking about coins of some sort. While many appeared and were readily destroyed, several of the larger creatures were more dangerous than others, with bolts of lightning causing harm to those around them. The constructs were present for several hours but seemed to disappear late in the night.

Patrols walking the Eastwyck/Westmarch border had reports of sightings of more of these creatures found along a road that had recently been appeared in the area. Of greater concern than the creatures themselves is the sudden existence of such a road.

Further investigation showed a hard-packed dirt road, wide enough for a horse-cart, wending its way up toward a mountain peak (where no peak was known to exist). It is lightly forested along each side, and various creatures can be seen lurking through the shadows. Most often can be seen stone-like lizards, some with strange elemental wounds (watery limbs, or chests with smoky, ember-filled holes, as examples), and these seem quite belligerent and territorial. The road itself is in fine condition for the first few twists, but further along displays dips, cracks and ruts marring its surface.

It was eventually determined that a similar road's appearance is not uncommon in the region, often tied to something known as the "Lost City."

Village Sacked

From what this reported can gather, there were several undead, including at least two with glowing eyes. Most everyone in this small village was brutally murdered, with two permanently dead, seven successfully resurrecting, one still missing, and two adults and four children making it out alive. It is rumored that the person missing was the most skilled in combat from this village. He was last seen fighting the undead while the few survivors escaped. Any more information about this incident would be greatly appreciated.

"You shoulda seen it! Them minotaurs, we'd heard a whole lot about 'em from over in Capulus, but I ain't never seen nothing so scary as the day they came to get us," said a farmer who wished to remain anonymous. As it turns out, the beasts attacking the small community were not the more socialized creatures who'd once helped former Duke Greystone restore order against the Sessai. These were minotaurs which had been changed, mutated into horrific, twisted forms of themselves.

One particularly large, vicious one, frothing at the mouth and bearing a massive weapon that seemed to be part of his form, appeared to be herding the others towards the small community. "Dozens of 'em! A whole tribe o' those beasts were comin' for us! I was up on the mountain and saw 'em coming towards the town, but wasn't gonna be able to get back to my missus in time to save her."

All seemed lost until Baron Cadoc Morbihan and his court arrived barely in time. After a lengthy battle, the snarling, threatening minotaurs were dispatched and the town was saved from certain doom. "We couldn't none of us have taken even a one of those critters. We'da all died!"

Ignavis

The Duchess Liara Kikkar of Ignavis was attacked and murdered by unknown forces on the night of July 11th, 608 E.R. Her Grace's Caravan was on its way to a Tournament she was hosting in Valrest Keep. Those few who were with her who resurrected have no memory of the events, although many have failed to resurrect. Her Grace's body did form; she died her final death.

Tyrangel

The combined Duchy troops of Tyrangel have broken the siege of Valrest Keep in Western Grond causing goblinoid forces to abandon their assault. The enemy has retreated a short distance and is fortifying a new line. Theisgate and Kingdom forces have had many successes in the South including the liberation of the enemies strategic Keep. These strong soldiers faced forces of 3,000 Goblins and Orcs and others reported seeing Elementals of Fire and Stone.

Himo the adventurer met his final death recently trying to save the lives of his two companions when the trio was attacked by a horde of Trolls.

In recent months, strange magical surges have been reported around the area of West Camp, primarily in the form of random celestial damage spells being increased in their effectiveness. With each passing day, the power surges became more and more frequent. Currently, all celestial damage spells cast in the area of West Camp seem to be having double their normal affect. This anomaly is contained only in the area of west camp and does not extend through all of Amberwood.

Ellistram Tamturr Darkstrider met his final death on Friday night of the past gather in Amberwood. He failed to resurrect after an attack by a local vampire.

Warrant for Arrest: Tybalt, member of Plan B. The crime he is to be charged with is Treason and Flight from Prosecution for masterminding and leading an assassination attempt on Constable Etaiu Denmroth and fleeing from prosecution by the aid of Guild Master Fazern of Nadia. It is at this time that this individual is to be detained with force if necessary. Any information leading to the capture of this wanted criminal shall be rewarded.

Willowdark

Beginning May 1st, 608 E.R, the Willowdark Academy is open for business. The Willowdark Academy campus is located approximately ten miles west of Wayside Lodge, at the crossroads between the roads between Wayside Lodge and Hangman's Pass, and Blackbeach and Elmrisen. It can be reached easily by road and is open to enrollment from all subjects of Willowdark and from visitors from other lands that come in the spirit of friendship and peace. It also has expansive classrooms, laboratories, workshops and practice halls and fields.

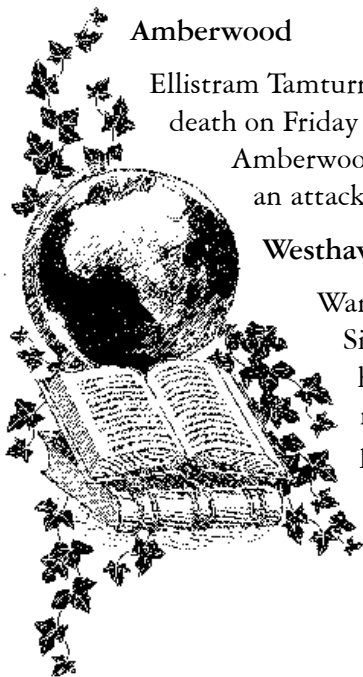
Twilight Falls

A Mage's Offering

Good people of Ravenholt,

I have spoken to many of you and welcome the opportunity to speak to any interested parties. I have come into possession of powerful formal magic scroll I would like to make available to the adventurers of Ravenholt. This scroll will help all of those that wield celestial magic, should people decide to take advantage of my offer.

Using this formal scroll, the caster is able to curse creatures with a weakness to a particular primal element (stone, lightning, fire, ice) for one year. Several different things need to be gathered for the formal to take place. 25 essences of a particular creature-type (goblin, lizard-man, kobold, etc.) must be obtained; any that have not been shown the proper process may inquire when I am next in town. Next, essence of the element opposite of what you are cursing the creatures with must be gathered (fire needs ice, stone needs lightning & vice-versa). A living creature of the given type must be part of the casting. The creature essences help power the formal, but other common components are required as well; 3 Power, 2 Spirit, 2 Elemental, 1 Creation and 1 Time. Please find me to discuss the specifics of the formal. This curse can not effect undead or elementals, but it has been known to affect other creatures that are not "living". Please be aware that I reserve the right to refuse a particular creature-type if I feel that it is unethical (i.e. elves, humans, gypsies, etc.). At the last gather, numerous shaman of Ravenholt and the surrounding area were somehow encouraged to gather in the woods, only to be attacked by alchemical casting rogues. Several townsfolk were able to get themselves placed within circles of power, but many were dragged away. Whiles the attackers dragged their captives away, someone was able to escape from the circles and go for help.

The town was roused to return to the area and search for the captives, only to find themselves amidst utter confusion as Barons Cadoc and Telaris began to issue orders that caused concern. Those still safely within circles began to shout contradictory orders, trying to inform the arriving rescue force that the two (and possibly others) were in all likelihood controlled by their captors and not to be trusted. The ambushing force appeared to have consisted primarily of civilized races, and seemed a well coordinated group, given their ability to capture some of Ravenholt's best and brightest.

Palace of Mirrors and Shadow Lords

Friday night a loud shattering sound echoed throughout the duchy. Later we learned that this was in fact "The Palace of Mirrors" which existed on the Plane of Light. The cause of the Palace shattering has yet to be determined by the Raven's Herald, but the impact was felt by all. 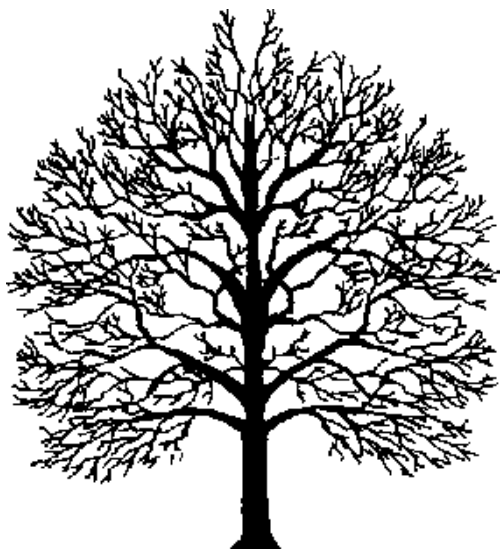
